All employees participate in safety meetings, first aid, CPR and Automated External Defibrillator training. Operations staff members receive additional training and practice rescue manoeuvres and safety exercises not normally required on the job but are valuable skill sets in the rare instance of an emergency.

For the community, Enersource has many electrical safety outreach initiatives, including the [eSMARTkids](#) website, and safety tips shared on [enersource.com](#) and social media. Enersource has also partnered with MySafeWork, to educate young workers on workplace safety regulations.
