ADD A SCOOP OF CONSERVATION TO YOUR LAUNDRY

November 9, 2016 – (MISSISSAUGA, ON) – When doing laundry, we recommend adding some conservation, along with your typical soap and fabric softener to every load. Washers and dryers help us keep our clothes clean but they can use a significant amount of energy.

The following tips can help reduce your energy usage:

- Use cold water to both wash and rinse your laundry.
- A water-level control or small-load basket uses less water for smaller loads.
- Clean the dryer's lint trap before every load.
- Avoid putting very wet clothes in the dryer. Run the spin cycle again or wring laundry out by hand.
- If drying more than one laundry load, put the second one in before the dryer cools.
