AIR CONDITIONER MAINTENANCE CAN REDUCE ELECTRICITY CONSUMPTION

According to several industry reports, replacing a dirty, clogged filter with a clean one can lower an air conditioner's energy consumption by as much as 15 per cent.

Ensure your air conditioner is turned off and vacuum the blades and protective grill to remove any blockages. Check for dirt or debris that may have collected over the winter and spring months. Also, ensure that your unit's air flow is not impeded by plants or other objects.

If you're uncomfortable doing the cleaning yourself, you may want to contact a professional ventilation/air conditioning cleaning service.
